SISTERSVILLE CAMPSITE RULES AND REGULATIONS

Applications will be processed on a first come first served basis.

Campers must register at the City Building, located at 200 Diamond St. before occupying a campsite, unless otherwise instructed. A campsite is not considered reserved until the rental fee has been paid in full.

No alcohol is permitted in the park.

Fires must be contained within the fire ring provided. Fires must be attended at all times. Use only firewood that is dry. Do not cut or damage live trees. Extinguish fires properly when not attended. Do not leave trash in the fire ring.

Trash is to be disposed of in the park dumpster.

Campsites are to be kept neat and orderly. Camper hoses must be neat and must be as close to or under campers, if possible, with any excess being under camper.

Quiet hours are to be observed between 10pm and 7am.

Pets are required to be on a leash and always have their tags on their collars. Pet waste is to be cleaned up and disposed of properly.

Check out time is 12:00pm. Please be courteous to other campers who would like to move their campers in place by 1:00pm. Your campsite must be left free of trash and debris before you leave.

All campers and guests must follow all campground rules, and all local and state regulations and laws. Violation of these rules can result in expulsion from the campground.
