Sistersville Park and Pool Camp Site Rules and Regulations

- * Applications will be processed on a first come, first serve basis.
- * Campsites that are not reserved shall be rented on a first come, first serve basis. Campers shall register before occupying a campsite at the City Building or calling (304)652-6361. A campsite is reserved when the rental fee has been paid in full.
- * One responsible person who has passed their 18th birthday, who is answerable for the actions and safety of the campsite occupants and liable for any damages caused by them, shall be at each campsite.
- * Camping in any manner is prohibited at the city park except at designed campsites.
- * Alcohol of any kind is prohibited on city property.
- * No more than 2 motor vehicles are permitted per campsite.
- * A campsite may only have one camping unit per site. Any additional units such as small tents must be approved by the City Hall Personnel and is subject to an additional charge.
- * Campsites shall be vacated by noon on the final day rented unless approved by City Hall Personnel.
- * Any camp fire must be in a fire ring. All fires must be extinguished if left unsupervised.
- * No objects may be driven in trees, shrubs, rocks, signs, or any other park property.
- * Quiet hours are in effect and shall be observed and enforced from 10:00PM to 7:00AM.
- * Generators shall not be operated during quiet hours. Motorbike riding is prohibited in camping areas, except to go to and from the campsite.

*No bicycles may be ridden in campsites after dark, unless equipped with running lights on front and rear of the bike. State law requires that all children under the age of 15 must wear a helmet while riding bicycles.

*Pets must be restrained on a sturdy leash not to exceed 10 feet in length and the owner shall clean up after the pet, keep it from disturbing others, and be responsible for any damages that may occur.

*All campsites must be vacated for Picnic in the Park (Sunday after the 4th of July) due to the fireworks put off that night, NO EXCEPTIONS to this rule due to safety.

The City of Sistersville and the Park and Pool Committee is NOT RESPONSIBLE for any damage occurred to any camping unit at the camp sites, these units are your responsibility.
